The Waste & Resources Action Programme (WRAP), a government funded not-for-profit company, is offering grants on a competitive tender basis to construction companies who are committed to lowering the levels of waste they send for landfill.

The WRAP, a government funded not-for-profit company, is offering grants on a competitive tender basis to construction companies who are committed to lowering the levels of waste they send for landfill.

The grants will be awarded to cover up to 30% of the cost of developing new or existing construction, demolition and excavation (CD&E) waste recycling programmes on construction sites. This includes plant, equipment and infrastructure.

The proposals which show a significant increase in the quantity and quality of CD&E waste recycling from construction sites will be the ones most likely to be awarded grants. Applicants must be companies based in England and be able to demonstrate that their proposed project will process waste that would otherwise have gone to landfill. The project in question must also be operational by 31 October 2010.

The WRAP is looking for applicants who will become leading examples and encourage others to invest in waste recycling.
